## First DDU-GKY centre inaugurated at Don Bosco Tech (Khunti, Jharkhand)



As per the standard operating procedure (SOP) of DDU-GKY project, a new skill training center under the aegis of Don Bosco Tech Society was inaugurated in Khunti district (Jharkhand) on June 25, 2015. The center is equipped with all modern state-of-the-art facilities. It is the first training center of DB Tech under the flagship DDU-GKY program of Government of India. The centre was inaugurated by Honorable Chief Guest Shri Neelkanth Singh Munda (Minister of Rural Development, Govt. of Jharkhand).
