The competition was held in in two categories i.e. above 22 years and below 22 years of age in nine trades viz. Electrician, Plumber, Fitter, Welder, Sheet Metal Works, COPA, Information Network Cabling, IT Network System Administration, Refrigeration & AC, CNC Milling, and CNC Administration, Reingeration & AC, UNC Maining, and UNC Turning.
