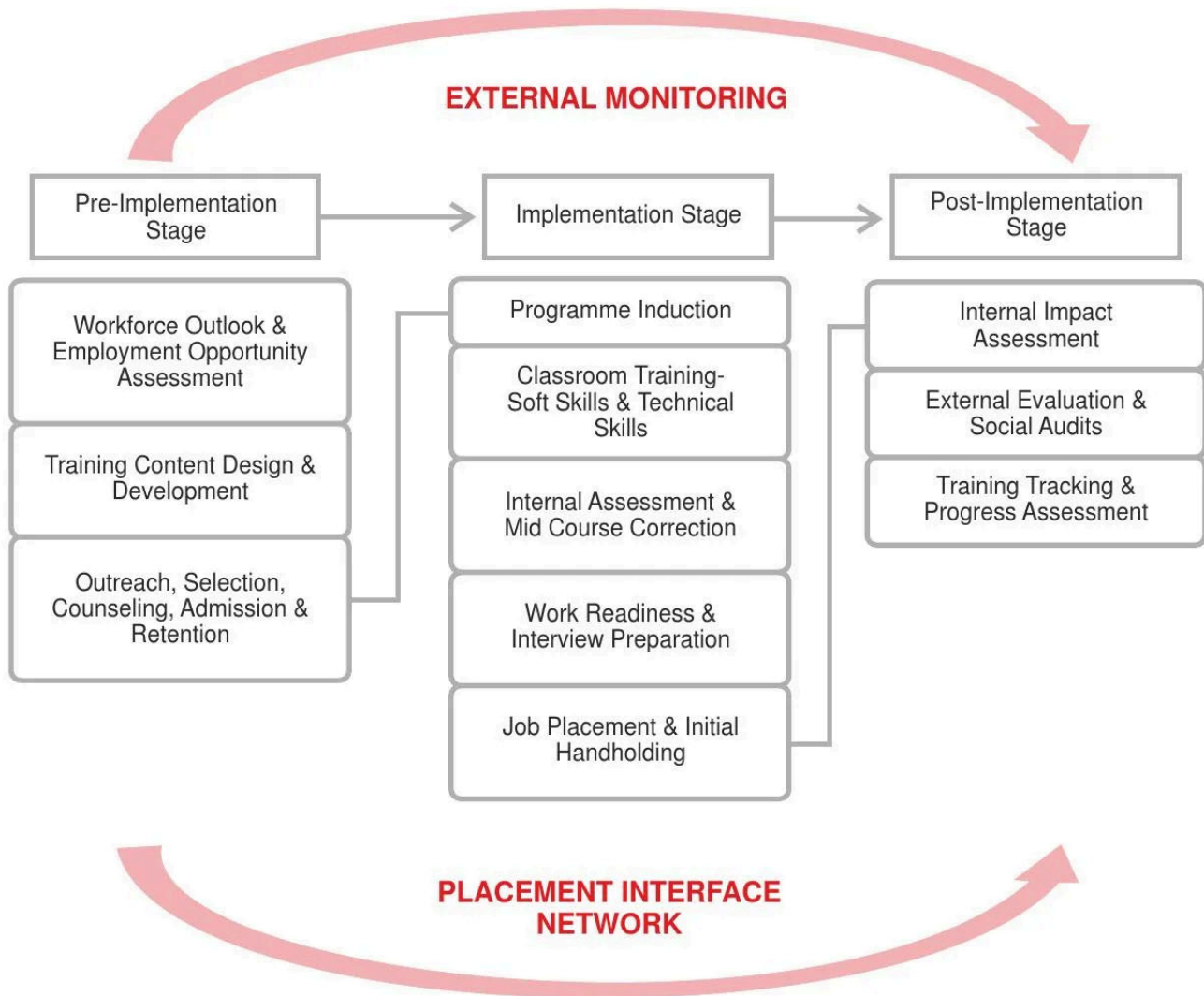

- Temporary accommodation provided for those who migrate to towns taking up jobs



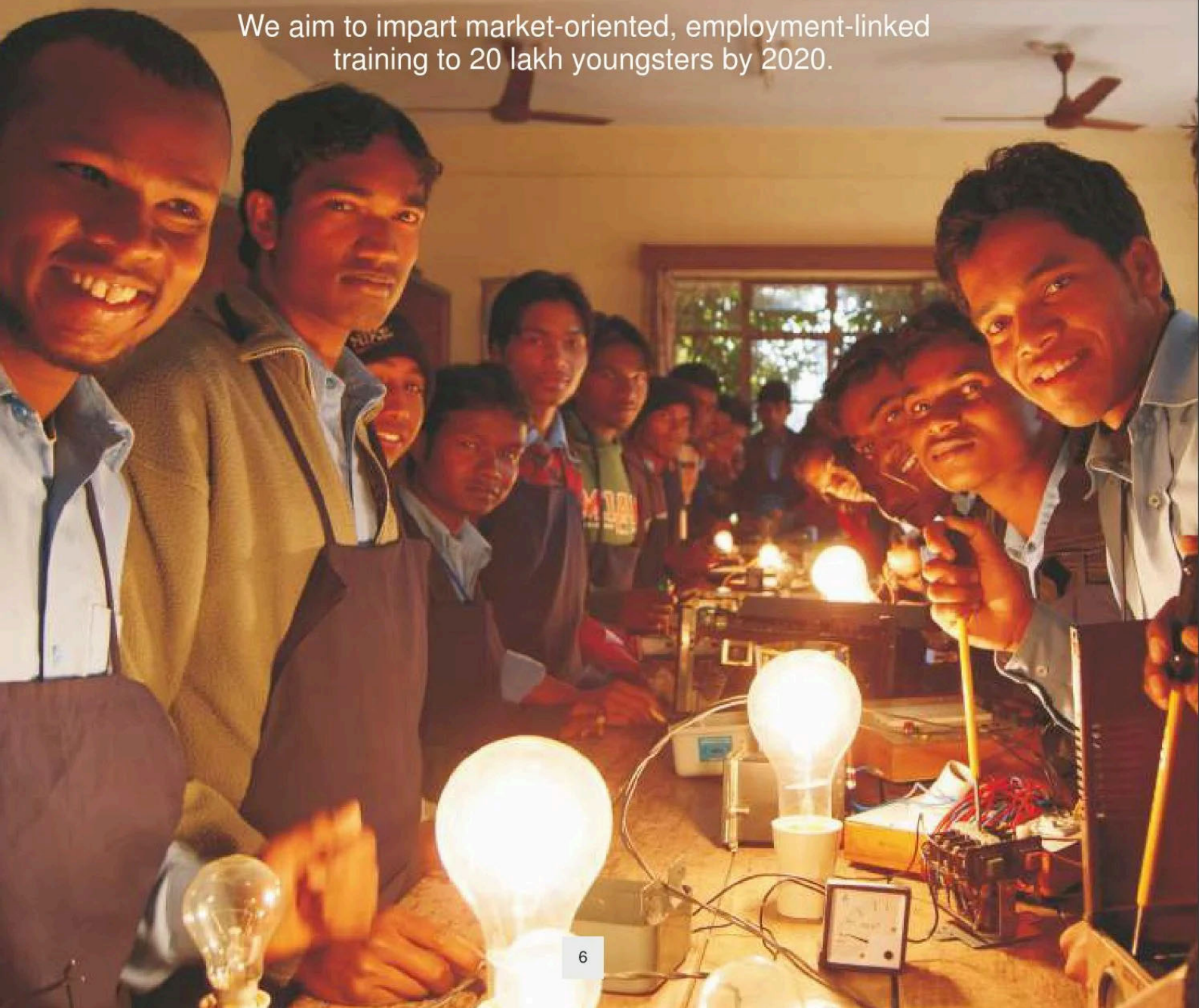
DB Tech – Skilling India
